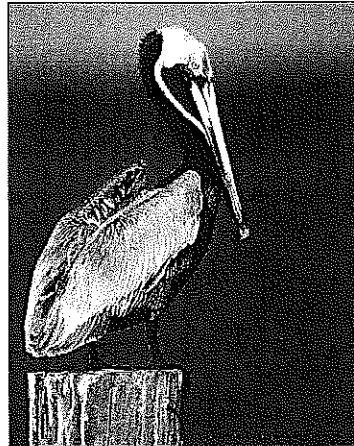


The pelican
